3. Total Other Receipts (-45%) Only Transparency Code and Grass Cutting Grant awarded (last year grant for Vehicle Activated Sign was included)
4. Staff costs (22%+) Transparency Code allowed for 3 hours per month staff costs, Clerk's attendance at New Clerks course – 2 days overtime
6. All Other Payments (100%+) – Purchased VAS (£2425), website built, hosting and domain (£815), Clerk's training (£150), Membership of SLCC (£82), election costs (£83), Charles Arnold Baker Book (£74) and Audit charge (£36) plus increase in costs of electricity and grass cutting = £3766
