

Dear Parents

Parking in Draughton Road

We are always concerned about the impact we have on our local residents as we are a successful school located in a small village. I am sure you will have seen at some time the many reminders and messages we distribute about careful and considerate parking: using The Stag car park, walking rather than driving if possible and avoiding the road completely when we are using coaches for school trips.

We have always been aware of the lack of suitable parking in Draughton Road and for your information we have for many years included the following mitigations to try and alleviate the worst effects on local residents:

- We send out ParentMail reminders regarding safe and courteous parking
- Our newsletters always contain reminders about parking
- We have maximised the places in our Breakfast Club and After School Clubs, as much as we can, to allow staggered times of arrival and departure
- We publicise Rob Willoughby's kind offer of use of the pub car park as a walk and ride. (*Thank you Mr Willoughby*)
- When using a coach for a trip we always unload all the children into the hall immediately to allow the coach to leave as soon as possible

We do not want to become a problem for our local residents, so once again we ask that you park considerately in Draughton Road, particularly near driveway entrances.




In further support of our local residents we have a number of additional ideas that we would be grateful if you would give serious consideration to:

- We will shortly be distributing a map (drawn up by the NCC Highways Department in consultation with local residents) that will show where it is appropriate and inappropriate to park. [This will be similar to the one sent out in the past on behalf of a local resident, Mr Unwin.]
- In the morning, children can be dropped off in the playground from 8:50am (when the Breakfast Club children have come outside with a member of school staff) and you do not need to stay on the playground with them until 9am
- Once you have dropped off in the morning or collected at the end of the day, please do not wait any longer than necessary in the playground. Please return to your car as soon as you can. *Idea:* If you make use of the park and walk offer from Rob Willoughby, you can always visit the pub to continue any conversations you start on the playground.
