Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting held on 26 September 2018

Present: Cllrs Calnan (Chair), Martin, Munro and Paybody

668. **Apologies for absence were received:** Cllrs Cornwell, Sanders-Hewett and Wright, A. Cowan (Clerk)
669. **Declaration of Personal and Prejudicial Interests** under the Council's Code of Conduct related to business on the agenda – None received
670. **Open Forum** – One person in attendance. Pete Redman, Secretary to the Neighbourhood Planning Steering Committee, commented on the proposal response to Daventry DC's consultation on the Settlements and Countryside Local Plan Part 2. He had thoroughly reviewed the Plan and distributed to Councillors a short report including a suggested letter to Daventry if the Council accepted the views he expressed.
671. **Planning:**
- **DA/2018/0692** – Outline application for detached dwelling. Land adjacent to The Banks, Harborough Road, Maidwell, Northamptonshire, NN6 9JA for PC decision. Discussion. A renewal of an existing outline permission which was considered to be consistent with the developing Neighbourhood Plan. Resolution to write to Daventry expressing no objection. Prop: Cllr Munro, Sec: Cllr Martin. Unanimous
672. **Settlements and Countryside Local Plan Part 2 – Proposed Submission Consultation (Regulation 19)** – response required by Daventry DC by 5 October 2018
Discussion. Councillors expressed grateful thanks to Mr Redman for his careful study of the plan and assistance to the Council on this matter. Resolution to write to DC (i) expressing concern about the reduction of the [SLA] from Draughton village to the Brampton Valley Way, (ii) supporting the maintenance of the SLA to the west of Hanging Houghton and Lamport (iii) requesting that the limestone landscape to the north of Maidwell incorporating areas east of Kelmarsch be designated as [an SLA] and (iv) requesting that Maidwell be designated as a "Secondary Service Village". Prop: Cllr Munro, Sec: Cllr Paybody. Unanimous
673. **Drain on A508, Harborough Road, Maidwell** – Discuss next step in light of Highways findings that a new system is needed (extremely expensive) and that, owing to the present climate, it would appear to be unlikely to happen in the near future.
Discussion. The lack of a definite timetable was unsatisfactory; Councillors wanted to keep pressure on the Highways Authority about this. Further correspondence was needed to emphasise the Council's dissatisfaction that the HA was not treating the matter as of the highest priority given the safety risk and the A508 being designated a red route. There was a feeling that, if no progress is made, the MP should be asked to help. Resolution to monitor the situation and put the matter on the agenda for the next meeting. Prop: Cllr Martin, Sec: Cllr Munro. Unanimous.
674. **Date and Time of Next Meeting** – The next meeting will be held on Wednesday 14 November 2018 at 7.30pm at Loder Hall, Maidwell.
