NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS
A14 between M1 junction 19 and A14 junction 2

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential maintenance work on the A14, between the M1 at junction 19 and the A14 at junction 2. During our scheme of work, we will:

- clear vegetation on the verges and in the ditches
- inspect all drains and replace damaged pipes
- resurface sections of the carriageway

Once our scheme is complete all road users will benefit from improved road safety, as the risk of both potholes and standing water forming will be reduced.

When will the work take place?

Our work is due to start at the end of **September 2019** and is scheduled for completion by **December 2019**. To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to local residents, businesses and road users, we will deliver our scheme overnight between **8pm** and **6am**, in phased shifts as follows:

- **Shift pattern 1:** end of September to the end of October, seven nights a week*
- **Shift pattern 2:** end of October to mid-November, Monday to Thursday
- **Shift pattern 3:** mid-November to the end of December, seven nights a week*

*To include 2-day breaks for shift rotations.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions, unforeseen circumstances and network availability.

How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we need to close the A14, in phases, between the M1 at junction 19 and the A14 at junction 2 while we work. We will close the A14 in one direction at a time to minimise inconvenience to motorists and the local community. When we close a carriageway, we will put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the Local Authority. And, all carriageways will be open as usual outside of our working times.

For further detailed information about our road closures, please refer to the attached drawing.

Polite request

To lessen overnight disturbances to the communities closest to our work, we politely ask all heavy vehicles to follow our signed diversion routes.
